Professor Wong Suk-Ying is currently the University Associate Vice-President, Professor in the Department of Sociology and Director of the Office of Admissions and Financial Aid.

Professor Wong received her undergraduate training at the University of Liverpool (UK) and obtained her PhD from Stanford University (USA). She has been on the teaching faculty at other higher education institutions in the United States and Japan before joining CUHK.
